Dear fellow Aussie Native Orchid Lover and Valued client,

2009, was to say the least, crazy, both with the weather, and Brian's Arthur -it- is, still giving him grief, prescribed medications (FOR THE Arthritis) , as well as other remedies, have helped marginally. Even drying the dishes at times is a physical effort, much to Phena's chagrin. The new crosses we have called 'Newbees', nearly all using new Mums or Dad's or both, with seven Tropicools and seven 'COOLS' more than we managed in '09. We didn't have a lot of plants to present at the 2009 Shows we participated in as a good percentage of our show plants were re-potted in readiness for the Australasian Native Orchid Conference in August this year, which will be an event not to be missed. The St. Ives Orchid Fair 2009 was our best ever with quite a number of our loyal customers placing orders and coming to the Fair to collect and discuss their successes with our crosses, in Shows in which they participated. Whilst our display, received numerous compliments from senior judges, DUNO customers and the general public.

We have had to make some regrettable decisions. As much as we enjoyed sending out our colourful catalogues each year and from the countless positive comments we have received from our clients over those years, you no doubt will notice a marked difference in this year's catalogue. Unfortunately from 2011 onwards we will no longer be able to send out future catalogues to our D U N O clients, the cost of producing and mailing out over 600 catalogues has been ever increasing, a cost we can no longer absorb.

For 2011 & onwards we will have to ask all our clients who wish to receive a D U N O Catalogue, to send a stamped self addressed business envelope to us requesting a catalogue, or enclose a 55cent stamp or whatever it may increase to in the future with your request, we do hope you understand and you continue with us as D U N O clients. It would always be available on our Website www.duno.com.au

On the brighter side of things & whilst we may not have had the plants that we would usually present at shows because of the repotting we did pick up the odd ribbon or two, Dockrillia LAUREN i.e., (Rosemary Jupp 'Chris' x Aussie Phil) Champion Australasian Orchid at the Newcastle Spring Show. Den. *tetragonum* 'Red Line' Champion Species at Ted Walmsley's Speciosum Show whilst the Warringah ANOS Spring Show Den. *speciosum hillii* 'Alba' judged as Champion Australian Native Epiphytic Species also Grand Champion. Also being worthy of an HCC/ ANOS. Den. *tetragonum* 'Wattagan #1' Champion Australian Dendrobium Species, in addition Reserve Champion of the Show at Orchids in the Wetlands. With the countless ribbons and awards both National & International at Shows, one could reasonably consider we are the leading Aussie Native Species & Hybrid breeder in this country. Speaking of International Awards, 21st February 2010 at a Major New York Show Den. *kingianum* (Fluro King x Chew Bacca) now 'Bacca King' AM/AOS 80 points the largest kingianum flower awarded to date. Den. Dunokayla 'Chunky Moon' HCC/AOS 79pts, a division of our plant so it now has HCC/AOC-ANOS -AOS to complete the title & Den. Tie-Dye was awarded 2 weeks earlier a CCM 84 pts - Over 700 flowers on 90 inflorescences, thanks Dick. Whilst still on the East Coast of America another of our clients has received an AM for a Den, Elegant Heart x Rutherford Sunspot in early March, cross has yet to be named. On the West Coast Santa Barbara Orchid Estate benched one of our Den. Duno Vivspot in a show in February and it received an AM/AOS. We participated in the Santa Barbara International Orchid Show there in sunny California in mid March, and put on a display with the theme 'Nature in Harmony'. Not only did the display receive a gold medal for an outstanding display, but was voted by the judges as the 'Best Foreign Exhibit Any Type Orchids' which takes in ALL foreign displays. We also received first in Dendrobium Species Australian with a division of our Den spec. *curvicaule* Daylight Moon FCC/AOC-ANOS x spec. *spec.* Watellow , two spikes and perfect, still waiting for confirmation on whether or not it was awarded.

No other Aussie Native Orchid Nursery comes within a bull's roar of our quality achievements over the past years, both here in Australia and increasingly overseas. The points are on the board.

The sarcophilus species/hybrids haven't had a good year, flowering was reasonable; a number didn't flower because of repotting, you can't say we didn't have a go. We did 92 pollinations, that was on 1st November, as at 14th February we have 12 still sitting there, maybe 6 look as they will be productive, who knows? But BEE ESS is pregnant, gooood. The seedlings haven't had an easy year either; dramatic weather changes in spring, summer & winter, the lack of rain no help, Then too much rain at the wrong time, humidity constantly around the 90% plus mark, in spite of this they are looking good., We had some success with unique crosses of Dockrillia's that we feel have potential plus.

We do hope that the new parents, our Newbees, and the excellent crosses using them, we are offering this year will be to your liking, and look forward to your feedback. Note that we continue to offer divisions of our Dockrillia's & others, in limited quantities again, so be early in placing your orders.

Don't forget the Australasian Native Orchid Conference 27th, 28th and 29th August at the Newcastle Panthers Club, We have been busy taking divisions (pieces of the original. if you like) of some of our breeding/ Show winning & sort after Dendrobium & Dockrillia Hybrids, PLUS we've done a number of 10 & 15 plant Flasks specifically for the Conference. There's MORE, there will be limited numbers of Dockrillia hybrids in 50mm TUBES that we are holding back specifically for the conference. Complete lists of goodies will be ready a month before the event. If you would like a list either by email or write to us we will return the list to you, when ready.

You keep asking, we keep trying, but with a difference. 'Lucky's Toy' our awarded Brinawa Charm with lots of gorgeous pink, flat as the proverbial 'pan cake' with the kingianum 'Boundry King' influence in the lip. With Candice contrasting colours, the mind boggles.

Lip same base colour with rivers of mid pink meandering over the surface, side lobes erect pollen cap white, raised golden callii. 7 different species in this lovely's background. With 'The Moon' doing the business it may be a Golden Moon or a rainbow of colour. 6½% bigibbum

- 2643 D. BRINAWA CHARM - REMAKE i.e., (PeeWee 'Keith' x *kingianum* 'Chew Bacca')
Charm with a difference. Thanks to our friends Rhonda (Office Mgr.) & Ross (Cedarvale Orchids) this remake was possible. Their 'Keith', as our PeeWee's a little shy. I was going to remake it, do it differently, hence our *kingianum* 'Chew Bacca'. Big blooms, great shape, pristine white background with fluorescent pink stripes. Gave Ross the pollen & Hey! Presto!
25% bigibbum VERY LIMITED 50mm TUBES
- 2680 D. ELEGANT HEART 'DOREEN' X XRUPPIOSUM 'THAT LONG'
Very spectacular 'Doreen' 70 - 80mm fruit salad coloured flat beauty, (the flower) crossed with XRuppium that had to be the biggest flower we've ever seen, 70 - 80mm high rich cream, heavy textured gob smacking perfumed blooms on a long arching spike. Result should be colourful, perfumed & lots of flowers. 12% bigibbum 50mm TUBES 80mm POTS @ \$12.00 EACH
- 2728 *D. ELEGANT HEART - REMAKE i.e., (PeeWee 'JOHN' x *spec. curv.* DAYLIGHT MOON FCC/AOC-ANOS)
Thanks to 'Legend' Ted Walmsley who gave us a plant of a real PeeWee. Had to remake Elegant Heart. 'John' is a luscious mid pink with a hint of yellow/Orange in the background. Lip a dark pink throat with the extremities of soft pink, & the dark pink forming a stripe to the lips end. Pollen cap white. Once again our ever faithful 'The Moon' provided the goods & are looking good, expect a 'different' Elegant Heart. 25% bigibbum 3 COMPOTS @ \$38.00 EACH PLUS 50mm TUBES
- 2736 *D. GOLDBERG 'ACADEMY' X YONDI TINA 'TUMBI'
PLUS C
More Newbees. Mum a 1616 cross, all have been tops, lovely golden hews with a splash of pink/orange present on the segments. Throw in our Yondi Tina with its pure golden segments, white lip & raised canary yellow callii. Don't like golden yellows; don't buy this one, with colchicine for added grunt. Similar to x2491. 3% bigibbum 50mm TUBES
- 2744 *D. VICSTU i.e., (DUNO BURGUNDY SHEEN x TWEED 'CANARY') X AUSSIE VICTORY 'SUPERNATURAL'
This New kid, texture to burn, golden butter yellow with a hint of pink blush on the extremities of the petals, lesser on the sepals. Lip pale golden yellow with darker pink markings, callii brighter yellow. Dad has a pleasing habit of doing everything right when used, texture like cardboard, intense marbling of deep rusty burgundy over a soft yellow base colour, lip darker rusty burgundy on white background, Champion at Gosford Spectacular '07. Should be a cracker
David Butler christened this one 6½% bigibbum 2 COMPOTS @ \$38.00 EACH PLUS 50mm TUBES
- 2756 *D. MONROE 'MARILYN' X DUNOKAYLA 'CHUNKY MOON' HCC/AOC/ANOS - AOS
We have certainly continued on with the new kids with this Mum. Stunning 'Extremely' crossed 'The Moon' gave us Monroe. 'Extremely' was almost a red large flower, the result was softer reddish beauty, texture and great presentation. Now 'Chunky Moon' Grand Champ. Warringah '08, a real mellow yellow, superb floral presentation, 'The Moon' is its Dad as well. This should produce Top Class kids. Whilst Dad has received a 79 point HCC/AOS in New York. Feb 2010. 3% bigibbum
5 COMPOTS @ \$38.00 EACH PLUS 50mm TUBES
- 2785 *D. WARRINGAH - REMAKE i.e., (*spec. cap.* PINE MOUNTAIN x *bigibbum* 'WILKO'S BEST')
This is a Warringah with a definitive difference, it will be squatter. We have gone for 'Pine Mountain as Mum, it is one of the first flowering speciosums, long arching spike cream /yellow blooms & lots of them. Importantly Mum has a short racus, the gap between base of flower and raceme. 'Wilko's Best' would have to be one of the best bigibbum's going around, bewdiful shape, great solid deep deep pink colour, great presentation. These are growing like crazy. 50% bigibbum 50mm TUBES
- 2807 *D. BUCKO 'BECKITT' X AUSSIE VICTORY 'SUPERNATURAL'
PLUS C
Hermon Slade Hybrid Winner '08, Mid to dark Rose pink beauty with the influence of the colour of Peewee and the twisty of Den. *tangerinum*. Its legs look like it has been riding horses for a long time; the arms are straight and the vertical doing the Chubby Checker 'twisting', just slightly. We know the 'Super Stud' Dad, texture like cardboard, intense marbling of deep rusty burgundy over a soft yellow base colour, lip darker rusty burgundy on white background, Champion at Gosford Spectacular '07. He should straighten things out, and give us a result that should be "very interesting" as Maxwell Smart would say.

- 2595 *D. AUSTRALIAN STAR GOLDBURST i.e., (IVORY 'GOLD' x spec. spec. WINDERMERE) PLUS C
We certainly didn't give that name to the cross. In spite of the name it has to produce loooong arching spikes of golden yellow blooms that sit on the spike & say 'Look at me - Look at Me' & have texture plus. 2 COMPOTS @ \$38.00 PLUS 50mm TUBES
- 2653 *Dockrillia* 'GREY GHOST' - TUMBI HCC/AOC-ANOS + AM/AOS X *Dockrillia fairfaxii* - aureum TUMBI PLUS C
Mum - Ira Butler 'GOLD' winner 2006. Grey/blue beauties relatively flat with a mulberry colouring at the junction of the segments, & a totally frilly recurving labellum, outstanding combination on a 30mm bloom. Whilst Dad around the 60mm plus in width, bone/white in colour, the lip that tapers almost to nothing in its recurving habit & that dark mulberry marking at segmental junction. Our expectations are very high with this combination. Mum, received an 82 point AM/AOS at a 2009 New York show, TOPS. VERY LIMITED 50mm TUBES @ \$11.00
- 2660 *D. COSMIC GOLD i.e., (AVRILS GOLD 'PLENTY' HCC/AOC-ANOS x spec. curv. DAYLIGHT MOON FCC/AOC-ANOS)
We had more material of this cross so we held it back until the plants were well established Using a better quality Mum & Dad, 'Plenty' awarded HCC after winning a show as First Flowered Seedling, and 'Daylight' devastatingly beautiful. You may have to wait a little longer for this to flower, but Hey! Should be an absolute Gob Stopper. Not an over abundance of these so be Quick. Thanks to David Butler for giving it the name. - 2664 *Dockrillia fairfaxii* - aureum 'TUMBI X *Dockrillia* GREY GHOST TUMBI HCC/AOC-ANOS + AM/AOS PLUS C
Reverse of X2653, & who is to know which will be the better of the two crosses, there's only one person who would know that, and he was more into fishing than orchids. Plus you may have noticed we colchocine treated both crosses. *fairfaxii* in itself has not long been recognized by RHS, all be it the *Dockrillia* part hasn't. Buy both, be Irish 'to be sure, to be sure' *Dendrobium teretifolium* var. *fairfaxii* (Müller ex Fitzgerald) Bailey, We do realize that *fairfaxii* as such isn't the full enchilada, so to save space on the tag and writing when it comes to that point in time, we'll stick to the name most people know it as, which is what we have done. - 2674 *D. *kingianum* 'CHEW BACCA' X ALPHA CENTAURI 'TUMBI' PLUS C
Our extremely beautiful 'Chew Bacca' doing it again for us having that heavy duty texture, great flower habit and the fluorescent pink stripping on a white background. Crossed that a relatively shy guy in 'Alpha' which is pristine pure white of around the 45mm mark and fragrance that would blow your sox off. To stiffen things up we added colchocine, not the little blue pills this time. 50mm TUBES
- 2677 D. TANGELOATS 'RAYENTHEL' X AUSSIE VICTORY 'SUPERNATURAL'
Fortunately we had spare material of this cross, & as it was so popular in '08 and '09, did more. Mum a bright coloured tangerine, almost concolour S & P's, lip ivory, red/orange splashing, plant borrowed from our good friends Ray & Thel, Dad, a very well known stud, texture like cardboard, intense marbling of deep rusty burgundy over a soft yellow base colour, lip darker rusty burgundy on white background, Champion at Gosford Spectacular '07. Cross may follow in 'Super's' steps, and what about the colour possibilities. 50mm TUBES @ \$10.00 - PLUS 80mm POTS @ \$ 15.00 EACH
- 2710 **Dockrillia fairfaxii* - aureum 'TUMBI' X *Dockrillia* AUSTRALIAN GINGER 'MERLOT'
Same as in 2664 & 2653 with Mum, but Daddyo was one of the 'Gingers' with a real splash of a beautiful merlot colour inhabiting the segments, so we hope that the colour from the Merlot will transfer to the size of the fairfaxii and have a happy medium. Anyway that would be after a few glasses. Not a lot from this cross, be Quick. 50mm TUBES @ \$11.00
- 2779 *D. RAY'S DREAM 'BURGUNDY BEAUTY' X REDMA i.e., (AVRIL'S GOLD 'GOSFORD GOLD' X JAZZ 'SWINGER')
We have more Newbees. 'Dream' more chunks, about 10% of the cream/white background sneaks through the mid to dark rose /burgundy pink on the segments with the arms & vertical almost solid colour. Legs bowed slightly, lip solid colour with a small white 'river' running down, and raised whitish callii. Dad, also a hunk, great texture soft gold/yellow background with heavy splashing of mid rose pink. lip white, upright side lobes with fine creeks of colour running around, Top result expected. 50mm TUBES
- 2793 *D. RAY'S DREAM 'CHUNKY' X HILDA POXON 'FIELD'S GOLD' PLUS C
But there is more. Similar to Mum in 2779, even more chunk, but with a deeper colouration. Whilst Dad came from our friend & Guru in the speciosum ranks, Lenny Field. Large 70 - 80mm yellow/gold blooms on the traditional arching spike, and lots of them, legs straight so should rectify 'Chunky's' minor leg problem. Expecting a mid-sized flower with good golden background, and lovely burgundy/rose markings. More Chunk with the colchocine. Don't miss out on this one. 50mm TUBES
- 9469 *D. YONDI TINA 'GOLIATH' FCC/AOC - ANOS - *** MERICLONES ***

- 9802 *Dockrillia striolata chrysantha*, a.k.a Tasmanian Gold - FOUR Divisions of the Original IN 50mm TUBES, PLUS 1 X 80mm @ \$17.00. Produces masses of golden coloured blooms on upright spikes, we grow ours in a pot & does well.
- 9808 *Dockrillia striolata* 'FRILLS' - ONE ONLY Division of the Original IN a 50mm TUBE
 'Ruffles' brother, slight difference in the lip ruffling, colour similar, markings not quite as definitive. Not quite as large a flower, a good grower.
- 9809 *Dockrillia striolata* 'VICTORIAN GOLD' - EIGHT Divisions of the Original IN 50mm TUBES
 Slight variation on a theme, but there is one, when you compare the Tasmanian *chrysantha* with it, buy both and compare for yourself.

DEAR CUSTOMER

We have several types of plants on offer & would like to tell you a little about them. Our culture notes are offered as a guide only, it works for us, so please be careful to try our ideas on an unimportant plant first and see if it suits your conditions. **For a complete version of Growing Tips/Culture Notes please go to our Website www.duno.com.au**

Our TROPICOOOL™ plants have a tropical species in their background, in most cases Den. bigibbum, a plant which is used behind many of the world's cut flower orchids. It lasts longer than most Dendrobium species & produces such flamboyant flowers. As bigibbum flowers in autumn, & most other commonly used species in our hybrids flower in spring, Tropicool™ orchids usually flower any time between May & September, with their peak at the end of July, early August. As a result, this type of hybrid has filled in the off season with wonderful flowers, & will tolerate as much cold as most other native Dendrobiums. The trick is to keep them DRY in cold weather. The colder the **DRIER!** In cold weather, when the bulbs start to wrinkle give them a good drink in the morning, avoiding the coldest days. If the bulbs are not wrinkling, they are not thirsty! Pot up into 80mm pots as soon as they are big enough. **DO NOT over pot!** Air movement is important, we hang our best (large plants, not seedlings). If you follow these guidelines you should grow them as well as your other natives.

Other Dendrobiums and Sarcocochilus

As with the Tropicools above, these should not be over watered. If you watch the bulbs you will see they generally wrinkle before the Tropicools, so can tolerate more water, but don't overdo it. Be guided by the plant bulbs! **Sarcocochilus** on the other hand don't have pseudo bulbs, so they have to be treated a little differently, in that in summer you can't afford to let them dry out as they don't have any water reserves, other than in their leaves. Water when they need it. Light doesn't have to be as bright as for Dendrobiums to grow them successfully, feed and treat them the same as ordinary Dendrobiums, except for the watering. In winter cut back as you do with Tropicools for watering.

General Avoid high Nitrogen fertiliser like the plague - it leads to soft, fungi prone growth and few flowers. We use a high potassium food with an N: P: K of 8:5:25, at a rate of one gram per litre fortnightly, all year round. We compliment that by using Amino K, as a foliar or drench application, this helps in the uptake of the potassium (K) maintaining higher levels of sugar & carbohydrates (from Horticultural Solutions). To get optimum results when using Pine bark mixes, it is a good idea to give your plants a drink of lime-water in early autumn and again in early spring. We use micro-fine lime (F70 Superfine Limestone) at a rate of one gram per litre. We also use and recommend Orchid Care Services treated pine bark. For seedlings, 6 parts fine, two medium, and 1 part 10mm river pebbles. Dendrobiums and Sarcocochilus up to 140mm pots, 6 parts medium, two parts fine and one part 10mm river pebbles, speciosum up to 140 - 180mm pots 6 parts medium, two parts coarse and one part 20mm river pebbles. For larger speciosum 6 parts coarse, two parts medium and one of 20mm river pebbles. Before potting (**using dry mix**) sieve the mix to remove all 'fines', put the fines on the garden or into your Cymbidium mix, if you grow them. When deflasking we add a capful of Envy (Stress-guard) to the water, soak the seedlings for 15-20 minutes in this solution, shake all the agar off the roots, in the water, then lay them on some damp newspaper. After potting we sprinkle a mix of sel-grit and canunda shell (50/50) over each pot; this is for a lime and calcium supplement. Now totally drench the plant to get rid of any missed 'fines', and thoroughly soak the bark to encourage the roots to grow into a nice new moist environment. This process could take up to 15 minutes, depending on the quantity of plants. **Do not** let the bark dry out in the early stages of the plants' potting into its new mix. **Morning sun is also very essential ingredient in maintaining a good healthy growing / flowering environment.**

We suggest that where we have made note of the fact a plant should be given a rest or grown in an intermediate house, that is where we grow them, or how we grow them, it is your final choice.

The fertiliser, Amino K, sel-grit/canunda shell mix, lime & HOZON™ line feeders, and their repair kits, plus DRAMM™ watering Wands & the fine rainmaking head (400) are available from the nursery, **AS WELL AS ULTRA FINE HEADS 750 & 1,000 HOLES.** **ALSO the small head (170) to work with the HOZON™**
