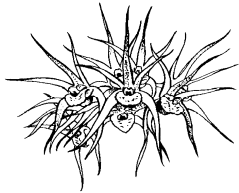

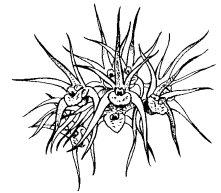

Dear fellow Aussie Native Orchid Lover and Valued client,

We have come to a decision which hasn't come lightly, that may not sit well with our loyal D U N O clients; this will be our **FINAL/ LAST** Catalogue. The time and effort that goes into getting our plants, flasks and catalogues ready, be it our Annual or Christmas specials has just become too much, as well as personal health issues. We also feel that we need to spend more time with each other as well as with our Grandchildren, after all none of us are getting any younger, are we?.

2010 was somewhat crazy, with the weather, which is something there would be no argument about, especially the poor Queenslanders and Victorians. Brian's Arthur-it-is, still giving him grief, plus other personal health issues, as well as the realization that our Grand Children we feel need more Grand parental influence. Jack now 18, our Grace 13, with Nathan 9 and Oliver Jack 8.

The decision made in 2009 to exclude us from a major event in 2010 on the grounds given, has had a profound and devastating impact on us both, and we feel we don't need that sort of stress with something we did so enjoy doing.

The Nursery definitely will be placed on the market this year (no rumor) with stacks & stacks of material in flasks & dry seed to be worked for future years, plus our quality Sarcochilus, Dendrobium Speciosum, Kingianum & Hybrid Breeding plants and new potential breeders that will be coming through.

WE have been at the wheel of D U N O for the past 12 years & in that time, we have produced some excellent crosses, received numerous Australian & International Awards, countless Grand Champion & other achievement ribbons. THE G. HERMON SLADE SPECIES Trophy for 2010 was given to our plant of *Dock. fuliginosa* 'Black Pam - Tumbi.' The Gold Ira Butler Trophy winner Dock. Australian Ginger 'Trish', our breeding, owned by the effervescent Trish Peterson and the Gold Bill Murdoch to Lorraine & Bill Dobson, with *spec. curv.* Daylight Moon FCC/AOC-ANOS x *spec. curv.* Blew Moon. Over the 12 years D U N O received two Ira Butler, two G. Hermon Slade Hybrid & two Bill Murdoch Gold Trophies, ten Silver Ira Butler trophies & countless certificates in all four fields in that period of time. As well our plants have been awarded, AM/'s & HCC/'s both here, New Zealand & the U S A. Our participation in the 2011 Santa Barbara International Orchid Show at which we were judged the Best Foreign Exhibitor ANY orchids, for the third time in four years in addition (*spec. curv.* Daylight Moon x *spec. spec.* Watellow) was judged Best Speciosum, in addition a plant we sold four years ago of D. Dunokayla received an 87 point AM/AOS. Other crosses that haven't as yet reached their maturity we consider to be potentially top class. All our breeding has had a particular result in mind as previous owner of D U N O the legend Neil Finch had done & he instilled in us that same attitude to breeding, unlike others in the Native Orchid breeding world.

The new crosses are nearly all using new Mums or Dads or both, we have called them 'Newbees', & reworked some material that was ever so popular in 2010, We have 5 Tropicools, as well as 6 new Dockrillia's we feel have potential plus in addition to 9 new Speciosums in this our last Catalogue. We didn't have a lot of plants to present at the Shows in 2010 or for that matter in 2009 as a good percentage of our show plants were re-potted in readiness for the Australasian Native Orchid Conference in August last year, If you failed to attend you certainly missed one of the best managed Conference's & well supported events that has ever been put in the public arena, the participating individuals & groups presented some stunning displays, well done Newcastle Australasian Native Orchid Society Group.

The sarcochilus species/ hybrids have had a bad year, flowering was reasonable; a number didn't flower because of the repotting, & you can't say we didn't have a go in the breeding department. We did 99 pollinations on 1st November, as at 14th March we have 14 still sitting there, of which 4 or 5 appear to be productive, who knows? Our thanks to Peter Jackson from Orchids & More of Tasmania for one of his excellent crosses included in this year's Sarcochilus Hybrid list.

We do hope that the new parents & excellent crosses, we are offering in this our final year will be to your liking, & look forward to your comments. We still continue to offer divisions of our quality Speciosums, Kingianums, Dockrillia's, Sarcochilus Hybrids, Tropicools & others, in limited quantities again. The number of plants in each category is substantial especially the Speciosums & kingianum & some goodies that have not been offered before, so be early placing your orders. D U N O has been the leading Aussie Native Species & Hybrid breeder in this country, the countless awards achieved at both National & International Shows speak for themselves, and the points are on the board. Remember don't hesitate to contact us if you have any questions or comments regarding the catalogue, the Website or any of your plants or whatever that may be causing you concern. **Possibly your very last chance to obtain quality divisions of D U N O plants**

For now we wish you happy growing & extend to you all our sincerest thanks for your support over the last 12 years. P & B N.B. - 2680 D. ELEGANT HEART 'DOREEN' X XRUPPIOSUM 'THAT LONG'
Very spectacular 'Doreen' 70 - 80mm fruit salad coloured flat beauty, (the flower) crossed with XRuppium that had to be the biggest flower we've ever seen, 70 - 80mm high rich cream, heavy textured gob smacking perfumed blooms on a long arching spike. Result should be colourful, perfumed & lots of flowers. 12% bigibbum VERY LIMITED 50mm TUBES
- 2728 D. ELEGANT HEART - REMAKE i.e., (PEEWEE 'JOHN' x *spec. curv.* DAYLIGHT MOON FCC/AOC-ANOS)
Thanks to 'Legend' Ted Walmsley who gave us a plant of a real PeeWee, had to remake Elegant Heart. 'John' is a luscious mid pink with a hint of yellow/Orange in the background. Lip a dark pink throat with the extremities of soft pink, & the dark pink forming a stripe to the lips end. Pollen cap white. Once again our ever faithful 'The Moon' provided the goods, Expect a 'different' Elegant Heart. 25% bigibbum 1 ONLY COMPOT @ \$35.00 + LIMITED 80mm \$15.00 & 50mm TUBES
- 2736 *D. GOLDBERG 'ACADEMY' X YONDI TINA 'TUMBI' PLUS C
From our 1616 cross a 'Newbee' in 'Academy', gorgeous shape and a base colour yellow with red/orange blushing and like all we have flowered a great lip. Our Yondi Tina isn't 'Goliath' by any stretch of the imagination but is a solid strong yellow 15 plus beauties on the spike. Combination should produce some ribbons, but it may be & we say may be a star, just like the Lady we named it after Whoopi. 3% bigibbum 1 x 15 PLANT FLASK @ \$40.00 + 3 COMPOTS @ \$35.00 EACH + 50mm TUBES
- 2744 D. VICSTU i.e., (DUNO BURGUNDY SHEEN X TWEED 'CANARY') X AUSSIE VICTORY 'SUPERNATURAL'
Texture to burn, golden butter yellow, a hint of pink blush on the extremities of the petals lesser on the sepals. Lip pale golden yellow with darker pink markings, calli brighter yellow. Dad has a pleasing habit of doing everything right, texture like cardboard, intense marbling of deep rusty burgundy over soft yellow base colour, lip darker rusty burgundy on white background, Champion at Gosford Spectacular '07. Should be a cracker, very popular in 2010. 6½% bigibbum 1 ONLY 5 PLANT FLASK @ \$29.00 + 2 COMPOTS @ \$35.00 each + LIMITED 80mm POTS @ \$15.00 & 50mm TUBES
- 2756 D. MONROE 'MARILYN' X DUNOKAYLA 'CHUNKY MOON' HCC/AOC-ANOS PLUS HCC/AOS
We have certainly continued with the new kids with this Mum. Den. Stunning 'Extremely' crossed 'The Moon' gave us Monroe. 'Extremely' was almost a red, large flower, the result was softer reddish beauty, texture & great presentation. Now 'Chunky Moon' Grand Champ. Warringah '08, a real mellow yellow, superb floral presentation, 'The Moon' is its Dad as well. This should produce Top Class kids and has been awarded an HCC/ both here and in America. 3% bigibbum 50mm TUBES PLUS 1 x 15 & 2 x 20 PLANT FLASKS @ \$40.00 & \$50.00 respectively LIMITED 80mm POTS @ \$15.00 EACH
- 2785 D. WARRINGAH - REMAKE i.e., (*spec. cap.* PINE MOUNTAIN X *bigibbum* 'WILKO'S BEST')
This is a Warringah with a definitive difference, it will be squatter. We have gone for 'Pine Mountain' as Mum, it is one of the first flowering speciosums, long arching spike cream /yellow blooms & lots of them. Importantly Dad has a short racus. 'Wilko's Best' would have to be one of the best bigibbum's going around, bewdiful shape, great solid deep deep pink colour, great presentation. - 2803 *SAIGON - REMAKE i.e., (BURGUNDY CREAM 'TUMBI' X AUSSIE VICTORY 'SUPERNATURAL') PLUS C
The original Saigon made by Neil has turned out some absolute mind blowers (not MINE blowers), a little de JA vu there. So we did the remake using the Burgundy Cream 'Tumbi' similar to "#2" but more intensity in the burgundy department, Just like a vintage Burgundy. Throw in our 'Supernatural' which has over the years of stud duty has produced some real crackers, and we can't see that this will be any different. Added colchocine so it could be even more than supernatural. 12% bigibbum 1 ONLY COMPOT @ \$35.00 & 50mm TUBES
- 2807 D. BUCKO 'BECKITT' X AUSSIE VICTORY 'SUPERNATURAL' PLUS C
G. Hermon Slade Hybrid Winner '08, Mid to dark Rose pink beauty the colour of Peewee & the twisty of tangerinum. Its legs look like it has been riding horses; the arms are straight & the vertical doing the Chubby Checker 'twisting', just slightly 'Super Stud' Dad, texture like cardboard, intense marbling of deep rusty burgundy over a soft yellow base colour, lip darker rusty burgundy on white background, Champion at Gosford Spectacular '07. Should straighten things out, & give us a result that should be "very interesting" as Maxwell Smart would say. 12 ½% bigibbum 25% tangerinum 50mm TUBES @ \$10.00
- 2811 *D. WARRAGUL 'MAGIC' X DUNOKAYLA 'MOONLIGHT' - CHAMP WARRINGAH ANOS '10
Mum an absolute cracker, pristine white base colour with vibrant purple/red random markings on the S & P's., similar colour on the back. Dad with its upright spike 12 plus parchment white blooms that just sit there and say look at me , with the speciosum 'rivers of purple running down the lip. with typical Kayla texture. Expecting more top drawer results with this one. 3% bigibbum 50mm TUBES
- 2863 *D. (BRIMBANK PINK ROSE x STAR OF GOLD) X *spec. curv.* DAYLIGHT MOON FCC/AOC-ANOS
One of the crosses we made in conjunction with our friends at Cedarvale Orchids, we supplied the 'Moon' dust, & Ross Harvey the Mum. Given that she has the unique parentage of having two Tropicools in Class x Intense, which did produce some excellent strong coloured goodies. Daylight will certainly put some starch in its habit. The combo of 'Rose' and 'The Star' produced some large good lookers. 3% bigibbum VERY LIMITED 50mm TUBES
- 2866 *D. (JAYDEN X RUTHERFORD SUNSPOT) X *spec. curv.* DAYLIGHT MOON FCC/AOC-ANOS
Another joint effort with Cedarvale. This time Ross has used a very early cross of ours as Mum which would have a great shape and colour mix. Throw in the Super Stud 'The Moon' and should give good strong spikes with that "box of Chocolates" colour possibilities. Thank you Ross AND Rhonda of Cedarvale Orchids. 3% bigibbum VERY LIMITED 50mm TUBES

- 2653 *Dockrillia* 'GREY GHOST' - TUMBI' HCC/AOC-ANOS + AM/AOS X *Dockrillia fairfaxii* - Aureum TUMBI **PLUS C**
 Mum - Ira Butler 'GOLD' winner 2006. Grey/blue beauties relatively flat a mulberry colouring at the junction of the segments, & a frilly recurring labellum, outstanding combination on a 30mm bloom. Dad around 60mm plus in width, bone/white in colour, the lip that tapers almost to nothing in its recurring habit & that dark mulberry marking at segmental junction. Expectations are very High with this combo. Mum received 82 pt AM/AOS at a New York Show 2009. **VERY LIMITED 50mm TUBES @ \$12.00**
- 2660 D. COSMIC GOLD i.e., (AVRILS GOLD 'PLENTY' HCC/AOC-ANOS X. *spec. curv.* DAYLIGHT MOON FCC/AOC-ANOS)
 We had more material of this cross so we held it back until the plants were well established Using a better quality Mum & Dad, than other Cosmic Gold's floating around the universe with 'Plenty' awarded HCC after winning a show as First Flowered Seedling, and 'Daylight' devastatingly beautiful. You may have to wait a little longer for this to flower, but Hey! Should be an absolute Gob Stopper. Not an over abundance of these so be Quick. Thanks to David Butler for giving it the name. So slow growing.

- 2664 *Dockrillia fairfaxii* - Aureum 'TUMBI' X *Dockrillia* GREY GHOST TUMBI' HCC/AOC-ANOS **PLUS C**
 Reverse of X2653, & who is to know which will be the better of the two crosses, there's only one person who would know that, & he was more into fishing than orchids. You may have noticed we colchocine treated both crosses. *fairfaxii* in itself has not long been recognized by RHS, all be it the *Dockrillia* part hasn't. We know that *fairfaxii* isn't the full enchilada, so to save space on the tag stick to the name most people know it as. **VERY LIMITED 80mm POTS @ \$16.00 EACH + 50mm TUBES @ \$12.00**
- 2669 **Dockrillia* VIRGINIA JUPP 'TUMBI' X *fuliginosa* 'BLACK PAM - TUMBI' **PLUS C**
 Virginia with *linguiforme* & *teretifolium* as Mum & Dad, carrying lots & lots of almost pure white 30 - 40mm recurring segmental beauties. Then there's 'Sooty' in *fuliginosa* with maroon/purple colouration & slightly closed segments. We know what results we have had with Tweetas & Australian Ginger; they have been 'Gob Smackers'. None of those have had the white or a recurring segmental flower as a co parent, Could be a whole new world of *Dockrillia* breeding lots of flowers with different result in the colour combo' stakes, Throw in colchocine. **LIMITED 80mm POTS @ \$16.00 EACH & 50mm TUBES @ \$12.00**
- 2670 **Dockrillia* AUSTRALIAN GINGER - REMAKE **PLUS C**
 i.e., (*striolata* 'PHENA'S RUFFLES' - Champ Wetlands '08 x *fuliginosa* 'BLACK PAM - TUMBI'
 Very colourful *Dockrillia* in 'Phena's Ruffles' having an excellent combination of colour from its parents, base colour being a sort of a German Mustard colour, with magenta stripes & a lip that rolls under slightly. 'Phena' knocked off 'Ruffles' AD/AM/ AOC-ANOS at the Wetlands. 'Black Pam' has proven to be an imparter of a mix of colours, intensifying in some cases, or just adding that raspberry 'spray - can' effect. As we have seen from other 'Ginger's', we expect top class results. **50mm TUBES @ \$12.00**
- 2674 D. *kingianum* 'CHEW BACCA' X ALPHA CENTAURI 'TUMBI' **PLUS C**
 Our beautiful 'Chew Bacca' doing it again, having heavy duty texture, great flower habit & the fluorescent pink stripping on a white background. Crossed that a shy guy in 'Alpha' which is pristine pure white of around 45mm mark, & fragrance that would Blow your sox off. Added colchocine to stiffen things, better for the plant than those blue pills. **VERY LIMITED 50mm TUBES**
- 2708 **Dockrillia* ETTA PLACE 'TUMBI' HCC/AOC-ANOS X *Dockrillia* SUNDANCE 'TUMBI'
 Two virgins in the breeding stakes. Whilst Mum having won a show and was awarded for her looks and presentation, which was a soft ice green Sepals & Petals and recurring lip in white with purple /pink markings. Then Sundance rides along and shows his 30mm plus off white S & P's with an extremely ruffled lip and magenta markings with similar colour at the S & P junction with Etta NOT Having P. N. G *Dockrillia* in its breeding we expect a new direction in colour. **50mm TUBES @ \$12.00**
- 2709 **Dockrillia* AUSTRALIAN GINGER 'BIG GUY' X *fairfaxii* Aureum 'TUMBI' **PLUS C**
 Another 'Newbee' and what a 'GUY' or in this case a girl, as mother. 'Big Guy' won class at a Warringah A N O S Show in '08, & was subsequently recognized in the Hermon Slade Hybrid Awards '09, The flower huge for a *Dockrillia* around the 25 mm plus mark, but the colour was just dynamic, purple /pink with a lip that was sensational. Put *fairfaxii* into the act with its 45 mm big ones and a good flower count to boot, potential top drawer. **1 x 5 PLANT FLASK @ \$38.00 + 50mm TUBES @ \$12.00**
- 2759 * *Dockrillia* TWEETIE 'HUGE' X *fasciculatum* 'TUMBI'
 'Huge' a relatively shy breeder, gets a mention in the Hermon Slade judging with its golden yellow base colour and maroon/red solid and spray can markings, 6 to 8 blooms on a raceme and can flower up to 3 sometimes 4 occasions in 12 months. 2779 D. RAY'S DREAM 'BURGUNDY BEAUTY' X REDMAN 'AMANDA'

i.e., (AVRIL'S GOLD 'GOSFORD GOLD' X JAZZ 'SWINGER')

We have Newbees. 'Dream' more chunks, about 10% of the cream/white background sneaks through the mid to dark rose /burgundy pink on the segments with the arms & vertical almost solid colour. Legs bowed slightly, lip solid colour with a small white 'river' running down, and raised whitish callii. Dad, also a hunk, great texture soft gold/yellow background with heavy splashings of mid rose pink lip white, upright side lobes with fines creeks running around, Top result expected, that is why we did more as it was so popular in 2010. Just hopeful that the result will be just like the British actress we named the Dad after, gorgeous. 1 ONLY COMPOT @ \$35.00 PLUS LIMITED 50mm TUBES

2829 **Dockrillia bowmannii* 'TUMBI' X *Dockrillia fuliginosa* 'BLACK PAM - TUMBI'

We are making it difficult for all you Aussie Native growers who have got onto the Dockrillia "Train". This primary hybrid should certainly be seriously considered to be added to the "Train". The lovely mid Granny Smith green of *bowmannii*, all be it with one or two blooms, but almost as flat as a pancake, combined with the 'Sooty' maroon colour of "Pam", the result, anybody's guess, but will be, we think an exciting step in the right direction colourwise. 2861 *D. (YONDI X GRAEME BANKS) X *spec. curv.* DAYLIGHT MOON FCC/AOC-ANOS

Ross (Cedarvale) has certainly given this every chance to possibly produce strong growing golden yellow beauties on a great spike by adding 'The Moon' dust to the Mum the floral presentation should be tops as well. LIMITED 50mm TUBES

DEAR CUSTOMER



We have several types of plants on offer & would like to tell you a little about them. Our culture notes are offered as a guide only, it works for us, so please be careful to try our ideas on an unimportant plant first and see if it suits your conditions!



Our Tropicool™ plants have a tropical species in their background, in most cases Den. *bigibbum*, a plant which is used behind many of the world's cut flower orchids. It lasts longer than most *Dendrobium* species & produces such flamboyant flowers. As *bigibbum* flowers in autumn, & most other commonly used species in our hybrids flower in spring, Tropicool™ orchids usually flower any time between May & September, with their peak at the end of July, early August. As a result, this type of hybrid has filled in the off season with wonderful flowers, & will tolerate as much cold as most other native *Dendrobiums*. The trick is to keep them DRY in cold weather. The colder the **DRIER!** In cold weather, when the bulbs start to wrinkle give them a good drink in the morning, avoiding the coldest days. If the bulbs are not wrinkling, they are not thirsty! Pot up into 80mm pots as soon as they are big enough. **DO NOT over pot!** Air movement is important; we hang our best (large plants, not seedlings). If you follow these guidelines you should grow them as well as your other natives.

Other *Dendrobiums* and *Sarcochilus*

As with the Tropicool's above, these should not be over watered. If you watch the bulbs you will see they generally wrinkle before the Tropicool's, so can tolerate more water, but don't over do it. Be guided by the plant bulbs! *Sarcochilus* on the other hand don't have pseudo bulbs, so they have to be treated a little differently, in that in summer you can't afford to let them dry out as they don't have any water reserves, other than in their leaves. Water when they need it. Light doesn't have to be as bright as for *Dendrobiums* to grow them successfully, feed and treat them the same as ordinary *Dendrobiums*, except for the watering. In winter cut back as you do with Tropicool's for watering.

General

Avoid high Nitrogen fertiliser like the plague - it leads to soft, fungi prone growth and few flowers. We use a high potassium food with an N: P: K of 8:5:25, at a rate of one gram per litre fortnightly, all year round. We compliment that by using Amino K, as a foliar or drench application, this helps in the uptake of the potassium (K) maintaining higher levels of sugar & carbohydrates (from Horticultural Solutions). To get optimum results when using Pine bark mixes, it is a good idea to give your plants a drink of lime-water in early autumn and again in early spring. We use micro-fine lime (F70 Superfine Limestone) at a rate of one gram per litre. We also use and recommend Orchid Care Services treated pine bark. For seedlings, 6 parts fine, two medium, and 1 part 10mm river pebbles. Dendrobiums and Sarcophilus up to 140mm pots, 6 parts medium, two parts fine and one part 10mm river pebbles, speciosum up to 140 - 180mm pots 6 parts medium, two parts coarse and one part 20mm river pebbles. For larger speciosum 6 parts coarse, two parts medium and one of 20mm river pebbles. Before potting (**using dry mix**) sieve the mix to remove all 'fines', put the fines on the garden or into your Cymbidium mix, if you grow them. When deflasking we add a capful of Envy (Stress-guard) to the water, soak the seedlings for 15-20 minutes in this solution, shake all the agar off the roots, in the water, then lay them on some damp newspaper. After potting we sprinkle a mix of sel-grit and canunda shell (50/50) over each pot; this is for a lime and calcium supplement. Now totally drench the plant to get rid of any missed 'fines', and thoroughly soak the bark to encourage the roots to grow into a nice new moist environment. This process could take up to 15 minutes, depending on the quantity of plants. **Do not** let the bark dry out in the early stages of the plants' potting into its new mix. **Morning sun is also very essential ingredient in maintaining a good healthy growing / flowering environment.**

We suggest that where we have made note of the fact a plant should be given a rest or grown in an intermediate house, that is where we grow them, or how we grow them, it is your final choice.

The fertiliser, Amino K, sel-grit/canunda shell mix, lime & HOZON™ line feeders, and their repair kits, plus DRAMM™ watering Wands & the fine rainmaking head as well as the small head to work with the HOZON™ are available from the nursery.
